

What is UCPath?

- A single payroll, benefits, HR, and Academic Personnel business system for all campuses in the UC System
 - Replaces current HR and Payroll systems
 - Provides one-stop employee self-service (UCPath Online)
 - Delivers improved online access to personal information & leave accruals for employees
 - Offers Manager self-service (NEW)

Guiding Principles for Change


- Ensure leadership and operational staff are prepared to support others through the transition

- Operational Alignment with UCPath Center







Employee Benefits from UCPath

- Common practices across UC locations in payroll, benefits, HR and Academic Personnel

UCPath is Going Live at UC Berkeley in March 2019

- First Pay for Monthly Employees April 1
- First Pay for Biweekly Employees April 3

What IS New and Changing?




- AYSO for current employees will now only have Beneficiaries and Retirement/Pension information
- You can always access your earnings statements through UCPath Online. No automatic notification about your earnings statements.
- New employee ID numbers will appear on the UCPath paycheck and in UCPath Online.



What to expect with Paper Paycheck

 Paper paychecks will be <u>mailed to</u> <u>your home address</u> on file, <u>on</u> <u>pay day</u> via the U.S. Postal Service

 Employees are strongly discouraged from using campus office addresses due to delays in receiving mail



Enroll in Direct Deposit


 Employees are <u>encouraged to enroll in Direct Deposit</u> prior to the transition to UCPath

 Visit the <u>Blu portal</u> to **enroll in Direct Deposit** to ensure your account is set-up prior to go-live

 If you are currently enrolled in Direct Deposit, you will not need to re-enroll. Your current Direct Deposit will automatically convert over to

UCPath

 After go-live, you can elect up to three (3) Direct Deposit accounts at the same or different financial institutions

- Confirm your personal data in Blu
- Sign up for Direct Deposit in Blu
- Sign up for online trainings (required for transactional users)
- Meet your departmental Pathfinder
- Visit the UCPath website
